ODU'S TED CONSTANT CONVOCATION CENTER LISTED AMONG TOP VENUES IN THE U.S.

Pollstar Magazine's 2016 year-end report has ranked Old Dominion University's Ted Constant Convocation Center No. 167 on its list of top venues, up 29 spots from 2015.

Spectra by Comcast Spectator, which provides venue management, ticketing and fan engagement services for the Ted Constant, said that among venues with fewer than 10,000 seats, the Norfolk arena ranked No. 17 worldwide, No. 5 in the country and No. 1 for venues on a college campus, according to a Jan. 19 news release.

The report is based on worldwide ticket sales and traveling shows and excludes sales generated from ODU sporting events. Pollstar Magazine is a trade publication covering the worldwide concert industry.
